

## **Faith Community Nursing Literature Reference List**

I started the *Faith Community Nursing Literature Reference List* in August 2012 and have continued to add to it, while maintaining it. Faith Community Nursing literature is defined as published research manuscripts, papers, presentations, dissertations, thesis, articles and books. This reference list is composed of APA references arranged in alphabetical order.

Process:

I receive Google Scholar alerts biweekly for both the search terms Parish Nursing (Nurse) and Faith Community Nursing (Nurse). I read to ensure that the piece of literature is indeed addressing or focused on the *Faith Community Nursing* specialty. Many times, I find that terms such as community, faith community, parish, or parish nurse mean other things. Such as, a parish = a district or parish nurse = a public health nurse. I also see that many health activities occur in the faith community but not by or with a Faith Community Nurse. In these cases, the citation is not added. I only add APA citations of Faith Community Nursing literature. If I cannot find the APA citation, I create one. Right now, the citations are in 6<sup>th</sup> ed. format or 7<sup>th</sup> ed. APA format. Since 2018, have used highlight colors to indicate the same year. Example: Aqua highlight indicates was published in 2021. In 2022, I changed the color of the text of citations published in 2022. Example: Dark Blue indicates that the citation was published in 2022.

The public can find this list at the Westberg Institute, Faith Community Nursing International, or the Journal of Christian Nursing. Please use it for scholarship purposes.
